A Letter from Jenn

We have so much to celebrate! In 2025, our ministry year focus was Home Team. In the foster and adoptive world, it can often feel like you're playing as the away team; no crowd cheering you on, and no one showing up to celebrate the wins or sit with you in the losses. Sometimes it feels like the stands are empty, and you're out there giving your all with no one to hand you a water bottle or say, "You've got this."

But we believe that this feeling of being alone was never God's plan. He created us for community, to support one another, to share both the wins and the hard moments, and to remind each other that we are not alone. Home Team is about building that kind of community, where every family is seen, supported, and surrounded by people who truly care.

This past year we saw that vision come to life in powerful ways. Hundreds of families gathered together for our **13th annual conference**, both in-person and virtually across the country, finding rest, encouragement, and renewed hope. Our Replanted Groups provided consistent community for **more than 300 families across 18 states**, supporting **627 parents and 956 children**. We **launched 10 new groups**, strengthened 30 leaders at our annual in-person leaders gathering, and created additional tools to help families stay connected at home. In a very personal way, I experienced the strength of this Home Team when I was unexpectedly hospitalized the week of the conference. Our team stepped in with excellence, our leaders showed up with care, and the ministry continued without pause. It was a clear reminder that Replanted has grown into a strong and sustainable organization, able to serve families well no matter the circumstances. We also took an important step forward by hiring our new Associate VP of Operations, helping us build an even stronger foundation for the future.

None of this would be possible without you. Your support makes it possible for families to find their Home Team. Because of you, parents feel less alone, children are supported, and foster and adoptive communities are growing stronger every day. Thank you for believing in this mission and for making this life changing work possible.

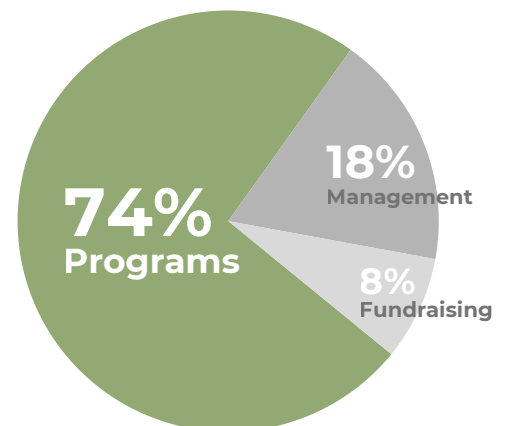
